SENATOR NEWELL: This is not debate. This is a letter that was just circulated that I just saw from Dave Howard, the Executive Director of the Commission on Aging which...

PRESIDENT: Is it attributed to any Senator?

SENATOR NEWELL: No, it is not.

PRESIDENT: That violates the rules. That violates the rules of the House. You had your initials on it. All right, that is perfectly proper. It is attributable to Senator Labeledz. Now, is Senator Bereuter around? Or Senator Goodrich? Here, Senator Newell, do you want a roll call or do you want the Clerk to accept votes? Call the roll.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 640. Roll call vote taken. (See page 1004, Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 13 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is indefinitely postponed. We go to LB 99. Senator Jack Mills moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 1 nay to raise the Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. We go to LB 99.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 99 until March 14th.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Unanimous consent to bracket LB 99 until the 14th? Seeing none, it is so ordered. LB 446.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Rules gives notice of public hearing in Room 1019 for Wednesday, March 8th at 8 o'clock. Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 446 in the Legislative Journal. Mr. President, LR 175 is ready for your signature.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 175.

SENATOR SAVAGE PRESIDING

SENATOR SAVAGE: The next bill is LB 446.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 446 was a bill introduced by Senator Bill Brennan of the 9th District. Title read. The bill was read on January 24, 1977. It was referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are pending, Mr. President, committee, Education Committee amendments by Senator Lewis' Education Committee.
