LB 575, 92A

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 575 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to advance LB 575 to E & R for engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 575 is advanced. LB 92A.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 92A be advanced to E & R for engrossment and request a machine vote.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. The motion is to advance LB 92A to E & R for engrossment and a machine vote has been requested. Is there any discussion? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I am curious, we are on Select File again and I don't find on my order of business for the day and, consequently, may not be real prepared for all of these bills that are on Select File at the present time. Is there any particular reason that we come up with this when it is not on the order?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: It is on the order. Everything we have taken is on the order for today and has been since yesterday afternoon on this order.

SENATOR DUIS: On the machine vote and all that sort of thing?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: A machine vote was merely requested by a member who can do that at any time.

SENATOR DUIS: All right. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Normally we don't have a machine vote as you know but Senator Cullan requested it as Chairman of E & R and as an individual legislator, I guess in that latter capacity, isn't it, Senator Cullan, not as Chairman of E & R, just as a member of the Legislature. Any discussion? Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: (Mike off) the bill, Senator Goodrich is the sponsor and he is not here at the moment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes, he is. He is right back here.

SENATOR NEWELL: He just walked in. I looked back there and couldn't find him. I wonder if Senator Goodrich knows that Senator Cullan has asked for a machine vote. Are you aware of that?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Frankly, I want to know what the devil is cooking because you have got LR 92. Are we dealing with a resolution or are we dealing with a bill?

SENATOR NEWELL: We are in better shape now. It is LR 92. It is your bill. It is on...

SENATOR GOODRICH: 92 itself, LB 92 not 92A.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 92A, if you will look on your agenda, Item #12, Select File, next to the bottom, we have run through all these bills. We are now on LB 92A and the

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
