PRESIDENT: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Call for the question.

PRESIDENT: Are there five seconds? I see five seconds. The question is shall debate now cease. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 11 nays on the motion to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Have you got anything to read in?

CLERK: Yes sir. I have the letter from me addressed to the Governor requesting the return of LB 457.

Mr. President, Senator Dworak asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 713A in the Legislative Journal.

Mr. President, Senator Simon asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 202 on E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: We have a request for a new bill, so please stay for that before recess.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to introduce Request #1509 by the Appropriations Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, there are two bills to be introduced, the one deals with the intent legislation that accompanies...well they both deal with the intent legislation that accompanies the appropriation bills. One dealing with higher education the other will deal with the general operations of state government. I move the bills be introduced.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is Senator Warner's request. Record your votes. This requires 30 votes. Have you voted? Record. We have one more. Two more?

CLERK: Mr. President, 33 ayes 0 nays on the motion to introduce.

PRESIDENT: Its.....

CLERK: New bill 957 (read bill).

Mr. President, Senator Warner now moves to introduce Request #1510 by the Appropriations Committee.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is one that is the intent legislation that deals with the operation of state government, accompanying the appropriation bills. I move its introduction.

PRESIDENT: The question is Senator Warner's second request. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the new bill. Read LB 958.

Mr. President, Senator Warner now moves to suspend Rule 3, Sec. 19 and place LB 957 and LB 958 directly on General File.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the rule be suspended so that the bills can be printed and be in the members hands tomorrow.
