maybe I should say it for the record that they would like to have me put the emergency clause at the same time.

PRESIDENT: It is in the motion.

SENATOR BARNETT: Fine. I thought it was.

PRESIDENT: Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned, Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Do you want to take that up right now or do you want to hold it until after Final Reading, Mr. President? Mr. President, do you want me to take that right now or wait until after Final Reading?

PRESIDENT: Well, we go to General File. We don't have any Select File. We can do it now.

SENATOR BARNETT: Okay, I move that we adopt the amendment and we have discussed it to great length. It is to change the date 1980 to 1979 and add the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: All right. We are on Select File. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to adopt Senator Barnett's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR BARNETT: I would move that we advance LB 212 to E & R engrossing.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is readvanced. We are back on Final Reading. LB 258.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Final Reading of LB 258.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 258 pass with the emergency clause attached? Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1182, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 2 nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 258 passes with the emergency clause attached. Read LB 258A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Final Reading of LB 258A.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 258A pass? It does not have the emergency clause. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1182, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 3 nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 258A passes. Read LB 406.

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
