LB 828, 851

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Would you address the question to the presiding officer?

SENATOR MARESH: I wonder if Senator Koch realizes the shortage of pheasants and Jack rabbits is due to the plentiful amount of coyotes.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I do not wish to be involved.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, sometimes the weather has an awfully lot to do with that too, the lack of habitat.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: This becomes argumentative and debate and I'll call that out of order. I think you have made your point, Senator Maresh. That's like telling the jury to disregard what they have heard. We'll go ahead then with the motion on the adoption of the Committee amendment on LB 828. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you voted? Senator Koch. Senator Koch, I'm going to call for the vote. Do you wish to do anything?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I'll live with the majority of the body here in their wisdom.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, record the vote.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 17 nays on the motion to adopt the Committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion fails. Now the bill is before us without the Committee amendments in it. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I move for the advancement of LB 828 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there any further discussion on the motion to advance LB 828? Motion then is to advance LB 828 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 828 is advanced to E & R Initial. Next bill on the consent calendar is LB 851.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 851.) The bill was read on January 16th. It was referred to the Constitutional, Revision and Recreation Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are pending Committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch on the Committee amendments on LB 851, Senator Koch. Senator Goodrich will you take the Committee amendments?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: The Committee amendment does nothing but strike the word "health care facility" out of the bill which is something I asked them to do any how, so I would move the adoption of the amendment so we can get the bill back down to just the commercial properties.

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
