

SENATOR CARSTEN: Now, Mr. President, I move that LB 907 as amended be advanced to E & R Initial. We're changing nothing really except that it does equalize the financing part that in some areas that does prevail. One other thing that I want to mention and it is kind of important. The procedures are here for the forming of the new district which does not literally change the boundaries any, but it has to be according to procedures, but one other thing that I need to mention and it is very important that the workmen's compensation, and as I understand, is questionable when the village firemen that man the fire machines and apparatus go outside the city limits and might become injured, there's a questionability there of the compensation being applicable and this then would take care of that. They would be covered if that district was all one. With that and the explanation of the amendment, Mr. President, I move for the advancement.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? The question then is the advancement of LB 907 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? I've already voted. We need one more vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 907 is advanced to E & R Initial. The next bill on the consent calendar is LB 643.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 643.) The bill was read on January 4th. It was referred to the Government, Military and Veteran Affairs Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are pending Committee amendments by that Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the first portion of this amendment we are reinstating the stricken language that we had in the bill so I would like in essence, to reject that portion of the Committee amendment and Senator Nichol has a corrective amendment that I understand is on the desk presently.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: So is the motion really to reject and then you will come back with another amendment? Is that it, Senator Stoney?

SENATOR STONEY: That's correct.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. Any further discussion then on the explanation of the Acting Chairman of the Government Committee? All right the motion then is to reject, is that right, Senator Stoney, the Committee amendments? All those in favor of rejecting the Committee amendments vote aye. Opposed nay. We're voting on the rejection of the Committee amendments on LB 643. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to reject, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion carries. The Committee amendments are rejected. Now, is there a motion on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, (Read Nichol amendment found on page 1210 of the Journal.)
