CLERK: No.

SENATOR SAVAGE: A point of order. Who asked for the point of order? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We are taking a vote and he is debating.

SENATOR SAVAGE: He is out of order.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

SENATOR DE CAMP: I'm trying to find out if there are amendments on it?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: There are none. Mr. President, there are no amendments on the desk, I made the motion and I think the motion is before the House and I think that we should vote on it.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Chair will...the Chair will...the Clerk will announce the vote.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 19 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The bill fails to advance. The Chair recognizes Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: I ask for a record vote, that is all. Mr. President, I had requested a record vote on that.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Go ahead and read it, that is what he wants.

CLERK: Read record vote. Vote appears on page 1239 of the Legislative Journal. 16 ayes, 19 nays, 11 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Anything on the Clerk's desk?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: No, wait a minute, I have one more bill. Move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 672.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to move the E & R amendments to LB 672. All those in favor say aye, opposed vote nay. The amendments are adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that 672 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance LB 672. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed say nay. The bill is advanced.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That is all, Mr. President.
