LR 605, 719, 722

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 605 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 719 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 719 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. Senator Nichol requests a machine vote on 719. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Shirley Marsh offers an explanation of vote. Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue whose Chairman is Senator Keyes to whom is referred LR 155 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, it looks like we're not going to again get to our preferred bills because if we just get started now, you wouldn't even get one of them out of the way and everybody would want to be going home. If we're going to continue at all we would continue on Select File because Select File is what's bogging us down and after all the appropriation bills start coming back you're really going to be in for it on Select File. So if you want to go for fifteen minutes or so, just going on down the line on Select File, it would be all right with me. If you want to do it, there is no objection. Mr. President, we could go for fifteen minutes and just go down the line taking the next one in order, 668. Who did? All right, then the next one, what, 7...?

PRESIDENT: We take up 722.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Okay. Fine.

CLERK: Mr. President, the E & R amendments to 722 were adopted by the body on March 7. There was a motion offered by Senator Rasmussen which was adopted. I now have pending, Mr. President, a motion offered by Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

CLERK: Senator, it's on LB 722, your motion to strike all of section fourteen.

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
