

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. Then, Senator Lewis came because he had not voted, made a motion to reconsider, which was accepted, acted upon successfully and no objection was made.

PRESIDENT: That was to reconsider the vote on your motion to bring it notwithstanding the action of the committee?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And no objection was made and the motion...

PRESIDENT: That is not a second try, Senator Murphy. On that basis alone, unless there is others, I would overrule your point.

SENATOR MURPHY: I will see you tomorrow, too.

PRESIDENT: I will match pedigree with you, if that is what you have got in mind. Any further discussion? Senator Chambers, do you want to close on your motion?

PRESIDENT: All right. The question is the adoption of Senator Chambers' motion. Record your vote.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I am going to ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is, shall the House go under Call? Record. The question is, shall the House go under Call? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: And did you want a roll call, Senator? All right. We are under Call. All Senators kindly return to your desks and record your presence. We have a roll call. We cannot accept votes. Record your presence promptly. All Senators, please return to the Chamber. We have two Senators who are excused. Senator Merz, we are under Call. Senator Schmit. We are missing Senator Goodrich, Senator George, Senator Labeledz. Commence the roll. Would you read the motion, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to set LB 620 for debate on March 20 for thirty minutes only and that is offered by Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: Would you read the motion, please, I mean the motion to be set. I had a request for that. All right, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 1333, Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on Senator Chambers' motion.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator DeCamp moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 1 nay to raise the Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. We go to Select File, LB 668. That will be laid over. LB 665.

CLERK: Mr. President, the only motion, the E & R amendments, LB 665 was replaced on Select File. The E & R amendments
