SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. Chairman, I have a question of Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Yes.

SENATOR HEFNER: I was wondering why we don't wait until they win the Championship and then...?

SENATOR COPE: No, we want this support that you're not going to support them at this time around. See, that will switch it then, I'll be back. I promise you. And incidentally, I just heard from my parliamentarians sitting ahead of me that we're supposed to vote for this the way it is written so please vote for it. I just got screwed up on my way of stating it.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes, this is the day you vote green, you know. That's right.

SENATOR COPE: Amen.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there any more discussion on the Cope at all resolution. All of those in favor of LR 195 vote green. Those opposed vote red. All right, record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the resolution, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Okay, anything else to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a study resolution introduced by Senator Richard Lewis, Senator Cullan, Senator Rasmussen, Carsten, DeCamp and Murphy. (Read title to LR 196 found on pages 1354 and 1355 of the Journal.) That will be properly referred to the Executive Board, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Be it so referred. Mr. Clerk, I don't believe that I stated that LR 195 passed. I did not. LR 195 passes. Is there anything further?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner would like to be excused at 3:30 today.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. No objections, so ordered. We will then proceed with agenda item nine on appropriations bills and the Chair would like to announce as Speaker, if you will look in your bill books, the new bills that under suspension were introduced yesterday, 962, 963 and 964, are in your bill books. Senator Warner will take them up if we have time following LB 946. So they will be inserted right after 956. With that, we'll proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with LB 956,

CLERK: (Read title to LB 956.) The bill was read on March 3. It was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.
