Emergency Clause to LB 868. Is there any discussion as to Senator Duis' motion to add the Emergency Clause? Senator Moylan, do you wish to speak to that? Senator Kahle do you wish to speak to the Emergency Clause? All right, so the motion before the House then is the adoption of...Senator Duis do you have anything further? The motion is the adoption of the Emergency Clause to LB 868. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Voting on the adoption of the Emergency Clause. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of Senator Duis' motion, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion carries. The Emergency Clause is adopted. Now, Senator Kahle and then Senator Moylan.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. President, I was in conference with Senator Duis and found out that they are going to put the bonding procedure on the...at a later time, so I will withdraw my....

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, the Chair recognizes Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I wish to support this bill and the advancement of it. Eppley Airport Authority in Omaha are greatly in favor of it and according to reports from the office from the Eppley Airport Authority, the treasurer, the County-City Treasurer of Douglas County is in favor of this too. In fact up there it is a duplication of services. The Airport Authority does all of the accounting and balancing out up there at the Airport Authority office and then they send it down to the County Treasurer and the same work is done over there, so it is a duplication of effort and they both would like to have the Airport Authority to have their own treasurer. So, I urge you to advance this bill.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. President, I move the previous question.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I don't believe that it will be necessary. We have no further lights showing, so...Senator Rumery if you will close. He waives closing. The question then is the advancement of LB 868 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 868 is advanced. Do you have some matters to read into the record?

CLERK: Yes sir, I do. Mr. President, Senator Cullan asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 793 in the Legislative Journal.
