

committee amendments to LB 248. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion passes. Committee amendments are adopted. All right, they are amendments. Just enter them into the record so that we can handle them.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Mills has amendments to LB 248 but I understand that he wishes to withdraw them. Is that....

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Mills will withdraw them. The amendments are withdrawn. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp has some amendments as well.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator DeCamp you are withdrawing your amendments?

SENATOR DE CAMP: Yes, for now.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The De Camp amendments are also withdrawn. Is there anything further then Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Senator Kremer, would you like to close?

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, not really a lot. Because, basically the committee amendments are the guts of the bill. There is one other thing that ought to be mentioned. The bill as amended does provide for certain hardship conditions. That is namely this. If a new dealer goes into business he will be limited to the D plates that he could possess in that the number of D plates issued depends upon the number of cars sold the previous year. So, a new dealer that is authorized and going into business would be very, very limited to the D plates that he could have because he has no history so it does provide for a hardship condition based on that example that I have just now given you. I think that what I said relative to the committee amendments, there is not much more to say and I would move for the advancement of 248 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Keyes, for what purpose....

SENATOR KEYES: He wasn't closing was he?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: He was closing. Yes he was. I'd asked him to close and that is what he was doing.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, well I won't talk.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion is the advancement of LB 248 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.
