LB 833, 920, 924

SENATOR SAVAGE: I just wanted to ask the same question. You reduce the fee from \$60 to \$50 the same as for a master, is that correct?

SENATOR R. LEWIS: That is correct, Senator Savage. It has been reduced down to the same as a master electrician's license.

SENATOR SAVAGE: This is for Class A too?

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Class A and B.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Thank you very much. That is what I wanted to have in there. My neighbor is a contractor and he has all kinds of licenses plastered all over his house. He has to have one for Omaha too.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the specific amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, no nays on the adoption of the specific amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: I would move that 833 as amended be advanced to E & R final.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 920 pass? Record your vote. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 1392-1393 of the Legislative Journal.
