Mr. President, new resolution, LB 200 offered by Senator Frank Lewis. Read. (See pages 1440 and 1441, Legislative Journal.) That, Mr. President, will be referred to the Executive Board.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Is there anything else? The Chair recognizes the Chairman of the Executive Board, Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Before I put the motion to recess, I think after lunch the first order of business should be finishing LB 953 which is almost done and then we can proceed with the rest of the agenda. So with that in mind, I move we recess until 1:30 p.m.

SENATOR SAVAGE: All in favor say aye, opposed vote nay. We are at recess.
