LB 966

Currency that goes directly contrary to one of our laws that we have on the books here, unlike most other states, and you have a letter, everybody has got a letter on their desks this morning from Mr. Riley the Banking Director and this new ruling goes into effect June 1st and the way it will work it would mean that the payroll accounts as I understand it of all banks that are state chartered won't legally be able to be there. They will all have to pull them. As I say, I think that you have all been talked to so this would introduce the bill and the next thing would be just like Senator Warner did put it on General File and the next thing would be to advance it. Do what you want. It is not a favor to me everybody, it is a favor to the Banking Department and everybody else. I'm not asking any special favors.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. This requires 30 votes. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, no nays on Senator DeCamp's motion, Mr. President. New bill, LB 966. Read LB 966. Mr. President, I have a motion by Senator DeCamp to suspend Rule 3, Section 19 to place LB 966 directly on General File.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to place the bill directly on General File, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator DeCamp now moves to overrule the Speaker's order and take up 966 on General File as of right now.

SENATOR DE CAMP: (mike not activated) read the letter. I would just make the motion to advance it. I don't want to discuss it or debate it. You have more information than I have about the bill. It takes 30 seconds. Do what you want. It is not a favor to me.

PRESIDENT: Record your votes.

CLERK: The issue Senator is to overrule the Speaker's order so as to vote on the advancement of LB 966 today.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays to overrule the Speaker's order, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Speaker's order is suspended, or overruled.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill. I should read the title again. Read LB 966.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: I move the bill be advanced and the only argument in its favor is that don't count this as a favor for me, I don't want this counted on my list you know.....

PRESIDENT: Let's don't keep books in here, Senator.

CLERK: I have a motion on it.

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
