SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, it was a question to the Chair, on exactly the issue that we were voting on, and it is evidently not germane now.

PRESIDENT: It was to overrule the Speaker's order.

SENATOR KOCH: But that was excluding the half-hour limitation?

PRESIDENT: No, it was for an hour.

SENATOR KOCH: I...

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry. I announced an hour. I probably should have said it again, but I announced that it was for an hour. Senator Marsh moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 1 nay to raise the Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Senator Newell, for what purpose do you ask recognition.

SENATOR NEWELL: I have a question of the Chair. I have the final priority list for March 20th and I was wondering is LR 152 on that...my understanding was that Senator Labedz and Senator Venditte both had made LR 152 priority items and I don't see it on this thing. Is that correct or incorrect, or what is the situation on that. It is a question.

PRESIDENT: I can't answer that. I am not privy to that information. I'm afraid that you will have to take that up tomorrow with Senator Luedtke on his return.

SENATOR NEWELL: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: We have three Resolutions coming up that will require 25 votes. I would ask the membership to stay in the Chamber until we conclude that. Would you bring up the suspension of rules on Mr. Yax please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marvel is excused. Senator Kelly moves to suspend Rule 4, Section 6 so as to take up...well perhaps I should read the Resolution. Read LR 201. Reread motion on suspension of rules by Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, if it is within the rules I would ask unanimous consent for the adoption of this Resolution.

PRESIDENT: We have to suspend the rules to take it up.

SENATOR KELLY: I move that we suspend the rules to take up these resolutions.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. This takes 30 votes. Could I have your attention please. 30 votes to suspend the rules to take up this Resolution regarding Senator Rasmussen's father-in-law. Please vote. Record.
