LB 046A, 184A

Jerome Warner as Chairman of the Appropriations Committee. Title read. The bill was read on March 21, 1978. It was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Bereuter.

SENATOR MILLS: Okay, will there be some more A bills following 184 then? Is there some more A bills on General File?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I imagine so. Whenever the A bills come up, we want to...right now, that is all of them, I understand. That is it now, but if there are any more, we want them all to go across.

SENATOR MILLS: All right, thank you. I see that little smile on Senator DeCamp's face and I just worry when I see that little smile come on his face, especially when a bill saying \$95,000, which again the paper says may not be correct, a little smile on Senator DeCamp's face, a smile.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak. The question is the advancement of LB 184A. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I hate to be a pain in the you-know-what but we have got to get the A bill with the bill. The rest of it is on Final. So I would have to have a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Sir.
