PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well I support the resolution, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, just a very brief clarifying remark. One of the major concerns is how much money we need, not who did what, when and where. The thing that I'm interested in and I know a number that support the resolution are interested in, is how can we be helpful? How can we help the people in my district and other districts that have gone through this situation? How much money we need? What federal funds are available? Certainly the purpose of the committee is primarily to help make assessments particularly in our own area, some of us that are affected, to help offer aid of this Legislature which has the sole responsibility of providing the money that is necessary to take care of that problem. So I ask you to adopt the resolution.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp has called for the previous question. Do I see five seconds? Called for the previous question. The question is shall debate now cease. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 13 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Do you have any amendments?

CLERK: Yes, sir. I do.

PRESIDENT: Read the amendment.

CLERK: Senator Duis moves to include the Chairman of the Administrative Rules and Regulations Committee.

PRESIDENT: Would you care to vote on that? All right, record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: It is adopted. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Question of the Chair.

PRESIDENT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR MURPHY: Our rules say that any special committee shall be appointed by the Committee on Committees. My question is if this Legislature adopts this resolution

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
