SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, both, LB 924 is the deficiency bill that does need to be enacted and over on the Governor's desk for his action and it would help to have that passed today. The other one deals with the ETV tower and it is ready for reading.

PRESIDENT: All right. The question then is, shall the rules be suspended to consider these two bills on Final Reading? There will be one motion for both bills. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays on the rule suspension, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: This is Final Reading. I should advise the people in the balcony that this bill will take well over an hour to read, perhaps an hour and a half. We are under Final Reading. The Chair would appreciate it if you would stay within the general confines of the Chamber. If you do have to leave, let the Chair know or one of the Sergeant at Arms and we will be in more strict order in about an hour and a half. Please read LB 924.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Final Reading of LB 924.

RECORDER TURNED OFF FOR FINAL READING OF LB 924 AND LB 945.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 945 pass with the emergency clause attached? Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 1614 and 1615, Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 945 passes with the emergency clause attached. That completes Final Reading.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined and engrossed LB 957 and find the same correctly engrossed; LB 964 correctly engrossed; LB 956 correctly engrossed; LB 952 correctly engrossed. Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk respectfully reports that she has on this day at 9:20 a.m. presented to the Governor for his approval the following legislative bills: 963, 962, 961, 960, 923, 813, 460, 836, 663, 665 and 202. Mr. President, new resolutions, LR 213 introduced by Senator Goodrich. Read. (See pages 1615 and 1616, Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, that will properly be referred to the Executive Board. Mr. President, new resolution, LR 214 introduced by Senator Cope. Read. (See page 1616, Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, that, too, will properly be referred to the Executive Board. Mr. President, Senator Kremer offers explanation of vote on LB 653 and 701. Mr. President, Senator Koch asks unanimous consent to be excused at 2:00 p.m. this afternoon. Mr. President, Senator Warner asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 965 on Select File.
