

did mandate where the solar and wind generating unit would be placed, and now we have allowed for the flexibility and also changed the word to "authorized" so that the Department of Roads can use their own cash fund, so it is not additional money, they can use their own cash funds and they are authorized to do this. Now, they will make the determination that it is not mandatory that they do it. The previous amendment mandated that they do it. Also we have asked the University work with the Department of Roads if they do decide to do this to check out and determine whether or not it will save energy and whether it is beneficial for other rest stops in the state. I would hope that the body would accept this. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 956 pass with the emergency clause attached? Record your votes. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 42 ayes, 1 nay, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 1679-1680 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 956 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that we recess until 1:30. Lets get back at 1:30.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall we be in recess until 1:30. All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. We are in recess until 1:30.
