

plans and specifications before letting bids to use the plans and specifications as the basis for receiving bids. Section 9 repeals outdated sections of the existing statutes and section 10 is the emergency clause. Now that is all that is contained in the bill. As I have said again, these are technical in nature and there is nothing that changes the intent of the amendments that were adopted the day before yesterday by this legislative body. I would urge you to adopt these amendments. I will be glad to answer questions if there are any but this was debated for approximately three hours day before yesterday and I would hope that we would not spend a great deal of time on this issue. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President and colleagues, and Senator Cullan, I have a question for you regarding your statement of Elkhorn only as it affects I believe in Section 7, sub (2) and is that your interpretation, is that your own personal opinion? Will you please give background for your statement?

SENATOR CULLAN: Certainly, I will, Senator Kelly. It was the intention of Senator Koch, who offered the amendment yesterday, that this exception applied to the Elkhorn Campus and...

SENATOR KELLY: Okay, thank you very much. That's enough. That's all I need from you now. That's all I need from you now and thank you very much. Senator Koch, in looking at the white copy on section 7, sub (2), Senator Cullan has stated that the Koch amendment put on this bill was for Elkhorn only and that he got that understanding from you. Now you have told me in complete straight across understanding that that include Central Campus also. Now are you correct or is Senator Cullan correct?

SENATOR KOCH: Senator Kelly, the purpose as I stated the other day is for land acquired prior to this date.

SENATOR KELLY: Now that would be Central Campus.

SENATOR KOCH: I am not familiar with that campus.

SENATOR KELLY: I am.

SENATOR KOCH: My concern was Metro.

SENATOR KELLY: But you told me that your amendment took care of Central and Metro.

SENATOR KOCH: If you have land acquired in the project, I would assume that that would be a part of it.

SENATOR KELLY: Okay, thank you very much, Senator Koch. Now, Senator Cullan, I would be back with you now for another question, if you would yield. You have now heard the statement from Senator Koch and do you deny the intent that he had for his amendment?
