PRESIDENT: Have you voted? Senator Goodrich, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, I really think that the body ought to go on record on this particular thing so I'm going to ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote when they get here.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record. Senator Goodrich, as far as the question of going under a call of the house, there's three absent which means that if you got every vote that came in you would lack the majority. You're entitled to roll call. Do you want the roll call? All right. Report the vote.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 18 nays on Senator Goodrich's motion Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Now, we go to the motion to override 92A. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I'd like to withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: All right. Now, what else do you have on this? What do you have up there?

CLERK: Mr. President, the committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed Legislative Bill 711 and recommend that same be replaced on Select File with amendments. 487 replaced on Select File with amendments. 404 placed on Select File with amendments. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed Legislative Bill 953 and find the same correctly enrolled. 956 correctly enrolled. 957 correctly enrolled. Mr. President your enrolling clerk respectfully reports that she has on this day at 2:30 p.m. presented the Governor for his approval the following Legislative Bills: 812, 955, 958, 954, 951, and 502. Mr. President, Senator Marvel asks unanimous consent to print a motion in the Journal--two motions in the Legislative Journal. Mr. President, Senator Fowler asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 713 in the Legislative Journal. Senator Chambers asks unanimous consent to print a motion regarding LB 184 in the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session, capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 953, 956, and 957.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to return LB 946A to Select File for a specific amendment. Would you like me to read the amendment Senator?

SENATOR WARNER: Well, no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: The amendment is to add in the additional funds that are required for the amendment that was put on by Senator Barnett the other day for longevity. If I can find which pocket I wrote the numbers down. Well, as I recall, what it requires is \$6,300 and some dollars of General Fund money and it runs through my mind about \$23,000 and something in cash funds for the Game Commission.
