LB 65, 624, 715

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion fails. All right. The next item on the agenda then is LB 715. Senator Rasmussen.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rasmussen moves to return LB 715 to Select File. The amendment being to adopt the Rasmussen amendment found on page 1235 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I'd like to return this bill. What these amendments do is to make sure that this bill doesn't interfere with the maintenance bill that we passed, Kelly and Cope's bill, last year. Also it makes the D.A.S. and the state agencies come together to come up with a workable plan that they can all use. I would ask for the return of the bill and the adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Newell, do you have your light on from a previous time or do you wish to speak? Any further discussion on Senator Rasmussen's motion to return? All those in favor of the return of LB 715 vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? I remind you we have only ten minutes to get about four or five more bills on motions. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 715 is returned. Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I would ask for the adoption of the amendments that I explained in bringing the bill back.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion then is the adoption of the amendment to LB 715, Senator Rasmussen's amendment. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? The motion is the adoption of the amendment to LB 715. Please vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Rasmussen's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Rasmussen's amendment is adopted. Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. Speaker, I would ask for the advance of the bill.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to advance LB 715 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. LB 715 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. Next bill. Senator Chambers has requested, has asked unanimous consent to pass over LB 65 on motions. Any objections? Move on then to Senator Reutzel's LB 624.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Reutzel moves to return LB 624 to Select File for specific amendment. Do you want me to read the amendment, Senator?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Yes, go ahead.
