LB 889, 889 A

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion and the second is the adoption of the Frank Lewis amendment. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the F. Lewis amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried, the amendment adopted. Do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, I ask to move the bill to E & R for Engrossing and I ask it be expedited.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion and the second is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrrossment with specific orders to expedite. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. The Chair recognizes Senator Koch in regard to 889 A.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, members of the body, I request that LB 889 A be returned to Select File for specific amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: And the specific amendment is...

SENATOR KOCH: The specific amendment is to amend the present bill to call for \$90,212, rather than a considerably higher figure that we had in there before. This amount of money will fund the ongoing programs for this one year only. After that time they will be falling under a different funding capability. I move for that.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is to return 889 A to Select File for the specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion is carried and the bill is now on Select File. Senator Koch, do you want to make the motion to adopt the bill?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment to LB 889 A.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion and second is to adopt the Koch amendment to 889 A. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Koch amendment, Mr. President.
