CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: The House is under Call. All Legislators return to your seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave and record your presence.

PRESIDENT WHELAN PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Please record your presence. The Clerk will take votes.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye. Senator Clark had voted aye. Senator Chambers voting aye. Senator Don Dworak changing from no to yes. Senator Fitzgerald voting no. Senator Maresh voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis, record your presence. Senator DeCamp. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Has everyone voted?

CLERK: Senator Simon voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: I'll ask for a roll call vote. If I counted right I'm one short.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, would it be out of order to have the amendment read to those who haven't been in here?

PRESIDENT: All right.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Burrows moves to amend: on page two and three of LB 828 by striking section five. (Read roll call vote found on pages 1787 and 1788 of the Journal.) 23 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The Call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Burrows now moves to amend LB 828 on page and... Well this is the same one. You've given me....it's the same amendment. Yes. Okay. Thank you. Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Who is to advance the bill? Senator Koch, do you so move?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 828 to E & R final.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. LB 907.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 907.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 907 be adopted.
