PRESIDENT: It's amended.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, I now move that the bill, LB 943, as amended be advanced to E and R initial.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, on the advancement of the bill Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill LB 803A introduced by Senator Cullan. It is a bill for an act to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 803, Eighty-fifth Legislature, Second Session, and to declare an emergency. Mr. President, the Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed Legislative Bill 632 and recommend the same be replaced on Select File. Mr. President, LB 448A was a bill introduced by Senator William Nichol. It is a bill for an act to appropriate funds to carry out the provisions of Legislative Bill 448 introduced in the First Session of 1977.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move we advance the A bill.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. This is to advance the A bill. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports that we have carefully examined and engrossed Legislative Bill 889 and find the same correctly engrossed. 889A correctly engrossed. 922 correctly engrossed. 407 correctly engrossed. 373 correctly engrossed. 271 correctly engrossed. 711 correctly engrossed and LB 87 correctly engrossed. Signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: We start on priority bills with 464.

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Bill 464 was a bill introduced by the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee and signed by the members thereof. A bill for an act relating to insurance to permit insurance companies to accept reinsurance for kinds of insurance that they are not authorized to transact directly, to establish applicable conditions and limitations, and to declare an emergency. The bill was read on January 24, 1977, it was referred to the Banking Committee, it was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments pending by Senator DeCamp's Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee.
