LB 128, 946A

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Cullan moves to return LB 128 to Select File for a specific amendment. Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. As I say, this is of a technical nature and does not change the intent but is necessary because of inadequate instructions I guess to the E & R staff and I have talked to Senator Brennan and Fowler and they feel that the E & R staff feels that this amendment is necessary and must be offered to give them some direction to change the bill. As I understand it, it does not change the intent of Senator Brennan or Senator Fowler or Senator Mills who were involved in this matter. That is the reason that I am returning the bill for this specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the bill be returned for the specific amendment. Record your vote. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, Mr. President on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: All right, the bill has been returned, Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, I would move adoption of the amendment. I have checked with Senator Maresch, of course, who has worked on this bill as well and he concurs that this was the intent when the amendment was adopted previously. So, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays on the adoption of Senator Cullan's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would move that LB 128 as amended be readvanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. In the south balcony, we have 30 eleventh and twelfth grade students from North East High here in Lincoln. That is in Senator Barnett's district. Thank you for being with us this morning. What else do you have, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to return LB 946A to E & R for Engrossing to correct an engrossing error. That is offered by Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Is that...it is written as a motion?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This bill has an engrossing error in it and all it needs to do is have it returned to E & R for Engrossing and then they could make the proper corrections and report it in properly engrossed. But, it is now on Final Reading, so they can not make that change. I would move that the bill be returned to E & R Engrossing for a correction of an engrossing error.

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
