SENATOR MILLS: The Clerk has some things to read into the Journal and then we'll recognize Senator Luedtke.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Simon asks unanimous consent to have his name added to LR 252 as co-introducer. Mr. President, Senator Warner asks unanimous consent to bracket LB 965 on E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR MILLS: No objections? Motion is granted.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined and reviewed LB 910 and recommend that same be placed on Select File, 834 placed on Select File with amendments, 854 A placed on Select File, 553 placed on Select File with amendments, 691 Select File, 564 Select File with amendments, 564 A Select File, 170 A Select File, 371 A Select File, 803 A Select File, 632 replaced. Mr. President, two new resolutions, LR 296 offered by Senator Sullan and Senator Stoney. It will be referred to the Executive Board, LR 297 introduced by Senator Cope. (Read LR 297.) Mr. President, that will be laid over.

SENATOR MILLS: The Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke, the Speaker.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, you have on your desks the Select File order which after we complete Final Reading

SENATOR MILLS: Could we have a little attention for Senator Luedtke please?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: ...and the motions this afternoon we will get on. I cannot stress too much the fact that we better get on Select File and work because all the work we've done getting bills off General File will be for naught if we don't settle down and address these matters on Select File because as I've said two or three times now everything will bog down on Select File and keep us from completing our work. So Mr. President, I move that we then recess until 1:30 and I hope we'll all get back here promptly at that time to continue with Final Reading to complete the day's Final Reading first and then go on with the rest of the agenda.
