LB 184A, 932

CLERK: Two.

SENATOR MARVEL: Two? Senator Barnett and Senator Hasebroock. Senator Bereuter, will you record your presence? Senator Koch, will you record your presence? Senator Cope. Senator Koch, will you record your presence please? Senator Keyes. Senator Mills, will you record your presence please? Senator Schmit, will you record your presence? There are two missing. Sergeant at Arms, will you find Senator Venditte and Senator Kennedy please? Everyone else is accounted for. We need Senator Kennedy. Have you found Senator Kennedy, Mr. Sergeant at Arms? We need Senator Kennedy and then we have got everybody that isn't excused. Okay. Senator Kennedy, will you please record your presence so we can start with the... did you ask for a... Senator DeCamp? Okay, proceed. All are present. Proceed with the roll call. Read again the issue.

CLERK: Mr. President the motion is to reconsider our action on final passage of LB 184A.

SENATOR MARVEL: For which we need 30 votes.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 31 ayes, 15 nays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 1947-1948 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried.

SENATOR DE CAMP: (mike not activated) them both then, that is normal.

CLERK: You passed the major bill.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Pardon? Okay, let it rip.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion has been reconsidered. The bill now is once more on Final Reading. Since the bill has already been read on Final Reading, the Chair will rule that all we have to do is vote on the bill once again. All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall 184A pass on Final Reading and the bill needs 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, Senator DeCamp, we are under Call. You have to return back to your seat like everybody else. Okay, the Clerk will announce the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 17 nays 2 excused and not voting.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried and 184A passes on Final Reading. Chair recognizes Senator Warner. Do you wish to be recognized on your motion regarding 932? Do you want to read it? Senator Brennan asks that the Call be raised. The Call is raised.

CLERK: Read Warner amendment regarding LB 932.
