

SENATOR SAVAGE: Pass that over.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill at that point.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance the bill. Is there any discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voice vote. All those in favor say aye, opposed vote nay. LB 713, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, 713, there are E & R amendments to 713, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Murphy. E & R amendments.

SENATOR MURPHY: (mike not activated).

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I then have a series of amendments. The first is...well the first one we will consider is that by the introducer. Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to amend. His amendments are on page 1661 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Would you read the amendment, Pat?

CLERK: Read Murphy amendment.

SENATOR MURPHY: This amendment relates to an issue that presently is foreclosed by our current law that says that a party at interest does not have access to juvenile records. This would permit that party, by identifying himself, a person identifying himself to have access to their own records and he can do so with nominal identification. But, if there is a question, he may then be asked to furnish a finger print for positive identification. It would not normally be required, but it is an ultimate and this would permit the person in custody of those records from giving him to an unauthorized person who claimed to be the party at interest. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion by Senator Murphy. Is there any discussion? The motion to adopt the Murphy amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please vote. We can get a lot of work done if we pay attention to what we are doing. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays on the adoption of Senator Murphy's amendment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Murphy amendment is adopted. What is next?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dworak moves to amend. Read Dworak amendment.
