SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I support this concept or I support this amendment because there are a lot of us that drive home every week end and we need to do this so that we stay in touch with our constituents and I think that this would be a very fair way to get reimbursed for some of these expenses. I support the amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, Senator Mills, you may close then. No close? So the question is the adoption of the Mills amendment to LB 153. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Mills amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Mills amendment is adopted. Motion carries. Senator Mills, do you want to readvance the bill?

- SENATOR MILLS: I move we advance LB 153.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The question is, the advance of LB 153 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Oppose: nay. LB 153 is advanced to E & R for Engrossment. Mr. Clerk, we will next read on Final Reading, LB 407 A. The reason we're reading it in that order is that as you recall that is a new and separate bill. It is not a normal A bill as follows 407 so we'll read it separately as 407 A on the list.

CLERK: (Read LB 407 A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions on law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 407 A pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 1973 and 1974 of the Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting and 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 407 A passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 748.

CLERK: (Read LB 748 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 748 pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1975 of the Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 748 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 777.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bereuter asks unanimous consent to pass over LB 777 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any objection to passing over LB 777 on Final Reading? If not, so ordered. The Clerk will then read on Final Reading LB 964.
