SENATOR BURROWS: Mr. Chairman, I have no objection to this amendment. I do not feel that it is not necessary. They have the rule and reg making authority, but if it will help and assure Senator Maresh that out of state landowners will not get away from the tax, I will support the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Have you all voted? Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Maresh's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill other than a request by Senator Marsh to have a machine vote.

PRESIDENT: All right, then the motion is to advance the bill. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record. Yes, Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: I move for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the House go under Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, no nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: All right, we are under Call. All Senators please record your presence. The Clerk shall take votes. We are under Call. Senator Simon. We are under Call. Senator Chambers. Senator Frank Lewis. Senator Venditte. Senator Cope, Senator Koch. Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 25 ayes, 10 nays, 13 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 2018-2019 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. All right, the A bill, do we have E & R on the A bill?

CLERK: No, sir. Just the advancement is all.

PRESIDENT: Is there a request for a machine vote? All right the question is the advancement of the A bill. Record your vote. We are under Call. The question is shall the A bill be advanced? Have you all voted? Record. Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: Mr. President, I would ask for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll. We are under Call. Non-senatorial personnel will leave the floor. Senators, return to your desk's.

CLERK: Begins roll call.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Senators are to be at their desks during roll call. All senators please go to your desks. We will wait until the senators return to their desks. Finish the roll call.
