SPEAKER LUEDTKE: It is just a technicality, but it is not a reconsideration.

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Luedtke, I think that we are going to get ourselves involved in a lot of delaying tactics.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: There is no need to argue about it. Do you want to appeal the ruling of the Chair go ahead so we can take care of it. Let's not waste all morning talking about it.

SENATOR DWORAK: I will not appeal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The...Senator Maxey, do you want to close? Senator Murphy had you....

SENATOR MURPHY: I believe that you had recognized me just before the objection was raised.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes, I forgot that you hadn't talked. Go ahead.
