LB 884, 884A, 887

SENATOR MARESH: I move that it be advanced to E & R.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to advance 884 to E & R for Engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. LB 884 is advanced. 884A, is there? Is there an 884A?

CLERK: Yes, Senator Maresh has amendments to 884A, I understand he wishes to withdraw.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, this is just to cut down the funding because the bill changed in its final form. I think that we need to cut down the appropriation on that.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there going to be any....

SENATOR MARESH: No problem. No problem.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, read the amendment and see if we can't get it adopted then. On the A bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh's amendment can be found on page 1854 of the Journal. (Read amendment).

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: I move the amendment be adopted. What this does, the Medical Center will provide 25% of the funding which the original bill didn't provide. I move that this be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the Maresh amendment to 884A, which in effect reduces the amount vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President on the adoption of the Maresh amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to adopt the Maresh amendment is adopted. Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 884A be advanced to E & R Final.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to advance LB 884A to E & R for Engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 884A is advanced to E & R for Engrossment. LB 887.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis has several amendments which I understand he wishes to withdraw. Senator...

CLERK: Senator Fitzgerald has amendments which he wishes to withdraw as well.
