LB 564, 564A, 861

SENATOR SAVAGE: The question has been asked for. I don't see five hands? I do see five hands. The question has been called for. All in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please vote. Please vote. Savage voting aye.

CLERK: Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Debate ceases and Senator Rasmussen, do you wish to close? Senator Rasmussen? Motion to advance the bill. All in favor vote aye.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: Outside of the fact that I can't close because it is my motion, I think that we are voting on the amendment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The adoption of the Simon amendment? Okay. The question is the advancement of the Simon amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote....Senator Nicol? Machine vote. All in favor vote aye.....vote the same way. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 20 nays on the adoption of Senator Simon's amendment Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion fails. Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: I move that LB 564 be advanced.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance LB 564. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. It is advanced. There is an A bill Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: I move that LB 564A be advanced.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Advance 564A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The ayes have it. It is advanced. LB 861 next. LB 861 Senator Warner.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to Lb 861.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Reutzel, will you handle the E & R amendments? Senator Cullan? 861 Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 861 be adopted.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance the E & R amendments to 861 all in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp has amendments pending to LB 861. They are on page 1775 of the Journal.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.
