CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The bill is returned. Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion is to adopt the Mills amendment to LB 128. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is the adoption of the Mills amendment to LB 128. Have you all voted? Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, members...Can you turn it on. Okay. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I am doing this for E & R so there is no confusion. Yesterday, we put an amendment on 760, and because I was talking from the floor, there was confusion when it got to E & R whether I was striking the Murphy amendment. There was never intention to strike the Murphy amendment for E & R purposes only to change the date to July 1, 1979. So E & R, does that satisfy you? Okay, so you have that straightened out.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Now what does that got to do with the motion?

SENATOR MILLS: Could I have the rest of my vote, Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, I know. I was just getting that done.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. Would we please vote on the motion before the House, then. I thought you were raising a point about the...I couldn't understand what point you were making. Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The amendment is adopted. Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: I move that LB 128 be advanced.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to advance LB 128 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 128 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. The next bill is number LB 828. Excuse me, we are going back down the other way, 965, because we have to move LB 965. It is a priority appropriations bill and it will require a lot of E & R work so we will take 965 and then we will come back, Senator Burrows, to your 828. We will return to that immediately. So it is 965. The first amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment, I have three different separate motions. The first is offered by Senator Warner. He moves to return LB 965 to Select File for specific amendment, the amendment being on page 2004 of the Legislative Journal. Senator, you have two different amendments, is that right on this?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, we can do them together.
