CLERK: Senator Ed Dworak voting aye. Senator Cope voting aye. Senator Koch voting aye. Senator Schmit voting no. Senator Clark voting aye.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any others wishing to vote? You may call in your votes. Motion is the adoption of the....

CLERK: Senator Merz voting aye.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Has everybody voted? Senator Dworak said call the roll and we will dispose of the matter. Does anyone want the Clerk to read the motion? All right, read the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to return LB 632 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment is on page 1892 of the Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Commence the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 2061, Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 14 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion fails. We will again by-pass LB 814 since Senator Richard Lewis isn't here and go on to LB 910A. Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit moves to return LB 910A for specific amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit. 910A, Senator Schmit, your return motion.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be returned, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Do you want to explain why?

SENATOR SCHMIT: And the reason for the return is that the bill did not provide start up money for farm operation at the penal complex. This provides \$25,000 for start up operation for farming operation at the penal complex. I move the bill be returned.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. Motion to return LB 910 A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The House is still under Call. Will all legislators please return to their desks and either vote or not vote whatever you want to do but get back to your desk because we are under Call. There is no need to have a Call. Have you all voted? Senator Schmit, the House is under Call. We can't hold the Board open much longer. We are under Call. Everybody is to be at their desks. All right. Record the vote.
