LB 875, 800A

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, the motion then is the return of LB 875 for the Warner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Would every body vote? It is on the return of LB 875. We still have a great number of these to wade through. You had better vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 875 is returned. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment as I explained it.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion is to adopt the Warner amendment to LB 875. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Warner amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner, motion to advance LB 875 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 875 is readvanced. The next bill is number 800A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 800A, Senator Merz has a motion to return LB 800A to Select File for a specific amendment, the amendment being: Read Merz amendment found on page 2064 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Merz.

SENATOR MERZ: Mr. President, as you know, we lowered from \$100 to \$60 a day so it don't take so much money. I think we have a switch here. We are going to save a little money here so I move we return this for this specific amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right, motion then is....Senator Simon, do you have a question? Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: Senator Merz, could you elaborate a little bit on what you are talking about. I haven't looked it up. Not very much, just a little bit.

SENATOR MERZ: What?

SENATOR SIMON: Don't elaborate too much, just a little bit.

SENATOR MERZ: Senator Simon, this original bill was for \$100 a day for the Power Review Board and as it was amended to \$60 a day so we don't need as much money to put it simple.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Does that answer your question, Senator Simon? The motion then is the return of LB 800A for the Merz amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes and 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 800A is returned. Senator Merz.

SENATOR MERZ: Mr. President, I move that we advance the bill.
