LB 709, 910

The House is under Call. Motion is to overrule the Speaker. I am going to hold the Board open, Senator Keyes, so that you have a fair vote. Do you wish a roll call vote, Senator Keyes?

SENATOR KEYES: I would like a call of the roll.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Roll call vote being requested. Proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 2060, Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Did you ask for a record vote, Senator Lewis? I want to be fair. That is all right with me.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 18 nays to overrule the Chair, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion fails. The Chair is sustained. We go on to the next bill which is LB 910, Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit moves to return LB 910 for specific amendment.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move the bill be returned. The reason for the return is that Senator Nichol suggested the last time we acted on this bill maybe 910 should contain the so-called Son of Sam amendment which provides that if an individual who is a resident of a penal complex should earn a considerable sum of money from book rights, movie rights, et cetera, that those rights, that income, would be considered a part of the responsibility of the inmate to this victim compensation fund, and I would move the bill be returned for that purpose.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion is the return of LB 910. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? The motion is the return of LB 910 by Senator Schmit, motion is to return. The House is still under Call. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The bill is returned. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the amendment be adopted, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion is to adopt the Schmit amendment to LB 910. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Schmit's amendment is adopted. The question is...Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be readvanced as amended.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to readvance LB 910 to F & R for engrossment. Senator Cullan asks for a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Machine vote. The House is under Call. All members will be at their desks. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

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
