LB 210, 553, 184

PRESIDENT: I don't know, Senator.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Then I think we ought to wait until he is here to vote.

PRESIDENT: That is a good idea, but the rule...

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: That is what the rules provide for.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: The motion, Mr. President, is that LB 210 become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor..

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Senator DeCamp wants a roll call.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 23 ayes, 24 nays, 1 absent and not voting, 1 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 2226 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. LB 184A (sic)...184.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves that LB 184 becomes law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call. 21 ayes, 25 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 absent and not voting, 1 excused and not voting. Vote appears on pages 2226-2227 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. 553

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Duis moves to reconsider our action on Final Passage of LB 553. That is offered by Senator Duis.

PRESIDENT: This is a motion to reconsider which takes the same constitutional majority of 30 votes. So, the question is, shall you reconsider your action. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT: Now the question is, this bill has already been read. The question is all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 553 pass. Record your vote. This takes 30 votes. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 13 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 absent and not voting, 1 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 2227-2228 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 553 passes. LB 170. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you arise? Excuse me, could we have the TV press conference move across the hall? We can not have this turned into a studio. Gentlemen, can we cease the press conference under the south wall? Sergeant at Arms, we can't have a studio in here.
