CLERK: 19 ayes, 6 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. All senators are required to return to their desks and record their presence by pressing the green button. If you are present, would you press the green button in front of you. Senator Reutzel, Senator Merz, Senator Clark and Senator Rasmussen are missing. Senator Rasmussen, we are under Call. Senator Koch, we are missing Senator Clark yet.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, Senator Chambers advised me that he would come down on this vote....

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers?

SENATOR KOCH: I'll wait for him to come.

PRESIDENT: He has been excused all day.

SENATOR KOCH: He is now in his office and I know that. He advised me that he would be here for this vote.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion under consideration is to suspend Rule 7, Section 7. (read motion).

PRESIDENT: We reconsidered it once, and it failed. The rules provide that if it once fails the only way you can do it is with unanimous consent. That failed. So, the only way you can do it more than once is to suspend the rules and then you can do it forever. 30 votes.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 26 ayes, 18 nays on the rule suspension, Mr. President. Vote appears on pages 2285-2286 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner offers an appropriation report on LB 952 on the Governor's veto message.

Mr. President, Senator Savage and Senator Moylan ask unanimous consent to print some material in the Legislative Journal.

Mr. President, Senator Carsten asks unanimous consent to print a letter to the Attorney General in the Legislative Journal (letter appears on page 2287).

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner. Does the Chair understand that there will be no attempt at override of 952?

SENATOR WARNER: That is correct, Mr. President, and I think that the body should be made aware, I think under the rules the Appropriations Committee is to make a recommendation. I don't believe that the Clerk read it. The recommendation that the committee voted, 952, is the only thing that was vetoed was legislative council appropriations in the amount of.....
