SENATOR MARVEL: I ask for unanimous consent to adopt this amendment. This is the one that I discussed when I made the report and this has been discussed with Senator DeCamp and Senator Koch.

PRESIDENT: You are altering your own report?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection to the alteration? It is still subject to a vote in total. All right, since there is no objection, Senator Marvel shall alter his report as announced. Do you have further matters on the report?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move adoption of the report as amended.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, no nays on the adoption of the report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: It is adopted. The Speaker will now accept suggestions on Resolutions that might be adopted on morn as we did the 56th day. In the meantime, the Clerk will read some things in.
