CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on E & R respectfully reports that we carefully examined Legislative Bill 917, 932 and 965 all correctly enrolled.

Mr. President, I have a Certificate prepared for transmittal of the override on LB 943, 953, and 956 to the Secretary of State.

PRESIDENT: There has been a motion to suspend the rules to take up LR 310 and to consider en masse on one vote the adoption of LR 299, 306, 308, 309, and 3010 (sic). That is the motion. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President and members of the body. PRESIDENT: Sure, we did that the other day. We went ahead and adopted them and then we read one, which I can't remember right now.

SENATOR KOCH: I remember that very noble resolution.

PRESIDENT: We are trying to save some time.

SENATOR KOCH: But, I'm talking about Senator Mills and others. I think that they....

PRESIDENT: There has been a motion to suspend the rules to accomplish what I had said. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, I asked yesterday for those we passed that they be read at the appropriate time. That would be near the end of our session today. I would certainly want those read yesterday and I understood that that was the way we would do it and we will do the same way with this one. We are about ready to quit and it becomes time for that type of ceremony that we read all of those, but not right now.

PRESIDENT: That is a good idea, Senator Frank Lewis. Senator Shirley Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Since, I have motions to include my name on several of those, I am a little hesitant about adopting all of them now unless that motion is at least taken up.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh has asked unanimous consent to add her name to how many resolutions?
