## LEGISLATIVE BILL 140

Approved by the Governor March 16, 1979

Introduced by S. Marsh, 29

AN ACT to amend section 60-2207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to control of noise; to change restrictions as prescribed; to eliminate a certification requirement; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-2207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-2207. No person shall sell, or offer for sale, a new motor vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of ten thousand pounds or more that produces a maximum noise exceeding the following noise limit at a distance of fifty feet from the centerline of travel under test procedures established by section 60-2210: (1) After January 1, 1972, 88dB(A); (2) after January 1, 1973, 86dB(A); (3) after January 1, 1975, 84dB(A); and (4) after January 1, 4960, <u>1978, 83dB(A); and (5) after</u> January 1, 1982, 80dB(A).

The--manufacturer,--distributor,---importer,---or designated--agent--shall--certify--in--writing---to---the Department-of-Environmental--Control--that--kis--vehicles sold-within-the-state-comply-with-the-provisions-of--this section-

Sec. 2. That original section 60-2207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
