PRESIDENT: So the question before the House is the advancement of LB 27 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 27 is advanced to E & R Initial. Time is about up. The Clerk has some matters on the desk. I just want to state at this time that while the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and I do sign LB 68. Mr. Clerk, proceed.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Revenue whose Chairman is Senator Cal Carsten to whom was referred LB 37 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be indefinitely postponed; LB 150 advanced to General File; LB 192 advanced to General File with amendments.

Mr. President, Senator Fowler offers a proposed rule change which will properly be referred to the Rules Committee for their consideration.

Mr. President, Senator Koch asks unanimous consent to print amendments in the Legislative Journal.

Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have examined carefully engrossed LB 68 and find the same correctly enrolled.

Mr. President, I have a reference report from the Reference Committee which will be inserted in the Journal. (See pages 321 and 322.)

Mr. President, Senator Simon moves to withdraw LB 459. That will properly be laid over.

And finally, Mr. President, Senator Koch asked to be excused for Thursday, January 25 and Friday, January 26.
