LB 47, 72, 73, 150

SENATOR PIRSCH: I would like to move this to E & R Initial and I think it is very needed. We need to collect this revenue. Mr. Art Bradley of the City of Omaha noted that special assessments billings in 1977 of \$186,000, only \$28,000 was collected and also of \$169,000 billed in 1978 only \$21,000 was collected. We need this bill and it would also save another mailing to the City of Omaha which would be in the best interests of the city and the state. Thank you.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The motion is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 150. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. My goodness, look at that. Better call the fire department or Tom Osborne, one or the other. I could have said record the vote but I didn't. This is a little game that they play around here. Senator Pirsch, you were the first one to receive this kind of treatment. It's not fair. Record the vote before they change their mind, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

Mr. President, your committee on Urban Affairs whose chairman is Senator Walter George to whom is referred LB 47 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File.

Your committee on Urban Affairs gives notice of public hearing in Room 2230 on February 14 and February 21,
