LB 561, 562

Mr. President, new bill, LB 561. Read title. (See page 424, Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The next request number then is Request #804 by the Revenue Committee. The Chair recognizes Senator Carsten. Senator Carsten, would you permit me before we do this, the Chair would like to introduce on behalf of Senator Rumery, Dr. and Mrs. Robert Daugherty, O.D. of North Platte. They are accompanied by their daughter Brenda of Lincoln and I presume they are sitting over here. Senator Rumery, are they sitting here under the North balcony. Senator Rumery, we are introducing the Daugherty's and I just wonder if they would stand up and be recognized please. Welcome to the Legislature. All right, now, Senator Carsten, you may proceed on your request number.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I move for the introduction of a new bill. This bill provides for two things. First of all, it will identify each political subdivision on the tax notice that the taxpayer receives which has authority to levy a tax. First it would give its current budget and also its previous year's budget. Secondly, on this notice would give the amount that each subdivision had in its previous year and also what the taxpayer will pay the current year. First it gives the budget and then it gives the amount for the present year and the past year. It is an informational piece that we believe the taxpayers are entitled to and would know more about their governmental subdivisions if and when increases are made or decreases are made.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion on Request #804, Revenue Committee, for introduction of bill. If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This will require 30 votes to introduce the bill. Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Read the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 562. Read title. (See page 424, Legislative Journal.)
