SENATOR MARESH: Thank you.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Any further discussion on LB 13? If not, Senator Nichol, do you have a close?

SENATOR NICHOL: I will waive closing.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Closing is waived. The question before the house is the advancing of LB 13 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: The motion carries. The bill is advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to read in?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, first of all, Senator DeCamp has a series of amendments to LB 316 that he would like printed in the Legislative Journal. (See pages 454-455 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have three Attorney General's opinions, one addressed to Senator Warner; one addressed to Senator Keyes and one addressed to Senator Duis which will be inserted in the Legislative Journal in full. (See pages 455-460 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your committee on Education whose chairman is Senator Koch to whom is referred LB 126 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File; 133 advanced to General File; 32 indefinitely postponed; 157 indefinitely postponed; 464 indefinitely postponed, signed, Senator Koch, Chairman.

Mr. President, your committee on Public Health and Welfare whose chairman is Senator Cullan to whom is referred LB 297 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File, signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman.

Mr. President, your committee on Ag and Environment gives notice of public hearing in Room 1520 for February 15; your committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation gives notice of public hearing in Room 1019 for February 15; your committee on Public Works gives notice of public hearing in Room 1515 for February 15, signed, Senator Kremer; and your committee on Revenue gives notice of public hearing in Room 1520 for February 26, signed, Senator Carsten, Chairman.
