LB 233, 411

SENATOR WARNER: No, this only deals with...oh, you mean the Resource Development fund?

SENATOR MARESH: Yes. Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: Well, we normally...those we always re-appropriate, regardless. They are...you know, they are not encumbered as we normally do it. They are reappropriated every year.

SENATOR MARESH: I see. Okay, thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: And again, that goes back to the same provision I discussed in one of the earlier bills. We cannot make a continuing appropriation. We have to reappropriate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments to LB 233. All those in favor aye, opposed no. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Warner, what do we do with the bill? Senator Warner, do you want to advance the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Excuse me. Mr. President, I move that LB 233 be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 233 as amended to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Are we ready for LB 411?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Legislative Bill 411 was a bill introduced by the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read by title LB 411.) The bill was referred to the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee, Mr. President, and was advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending.
