PRESIDENT: Is there any objection? LB 146 will be passed over. LB 287, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendment to LB 287.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendment on LB 287. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments on LB 287 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. It passes this time by a vote of two to one. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move LB 287 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB 287 to E & R for engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 287 is advanced to E & R for engrossment.

Mr. President, your committee on Public Health and Welfare whose chairman is Senator Cullan to whom is referred LB 506 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File; LB 198 advanced to General File; LB 174 advanced to General File; LB 428 advanced to General File and LB 370 indefinitely postponed, signed, Senator Cullan, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I have an inquiry. I do not know who authorized putting on the desks in the Court of Industrial Relations in the State of Nebraska, opinion and order. If there is a name on it, I cannot read it and I thought perhaps whoever had authorized it would identify himself or herself.
